If you're like me, you may be unfamiliar with the term, but not the actual practice: According to Merriam Webster, Doomscrolling is "the tendency to continue to surf or scroll through bad news, even though that news is saddening, disheartening, or depressing." This behavior usually makes us feel worse, not better.

What's the cure? Taking action that will make a difference in the world. What can you do? Save a child from a life of poverty – sponsor a child for secondary school! It only costs \$425 for a year of boarding school tuition, books, uniforms, and school supplies.

We have over 30 bright kids who just passed their national exams at the end of 7th grade who need support to go on to boarding school. Why boarding? In Tanzania, the local day schools for junior and senior high school are not taught in English, and children have to walk several miles each way every day – taking valuable time away from their studies. Boarding schools provide a much higher level of education, the kids are fed meals every day, and have a safe place with electricity to do their homework each evening. The environment is built to support their success.

The COVID-19 pandemic is estimated to push an additional 88 million to 115 million people into extreme poverty this year, with the total rising to as many as 150 million by 2021, depending on the severity of the economic contraction. Extreme poverty, defined as living on less than \$1.90 a day, is likely to affect nearly 10 % of the world's population in 2020. For kids in school, this means lunch is likely the only meal they can count on.

Unfortunately, Tloma Primary School doesn't have a budget for school lunches – but together we can change that! For as little as \$22, you can provide a hot lunch to the school's 730 kids for a day. Can you help them out?
